  - a. FACILITIES John
    - i. PARK COUNTY REGULATIONS:

      - Height peak of shed roof line (center line) can be 10 feet off the ground
      - 1 shed per property
      - CORA Board will review clarification of convent regulations
    - ii. Roads -finished road base SN this fall.
