### **Questions Asked**

#### Why can't we us four wheelers and golf carts?

In 2000 the members approved revisions to the Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions for Campground of the Rockies. Article 6.7 states: "All vehicles operated within the Common Elements shall be licensed, operated by a licensed driver and driven on platted roads only. Roads or trails have been designated for use by the following unlicensed vehicles: none, except as approved by the Board of Directors to make reasonable accommodation for disabilities. The above listed vehicles are permitted on platted roads only if driven by licensed and insured drivers and are subject to the Rules and Regulations of the Association, including noise and speed limitations and requirements for the use of proper equipment."

## Why was a water meter put on the pool?

Park County has requested that a water meter be placed on the pool to monitor the water usage. This is due to the drought and water shortage.
