

COVID-19 – What is happening at CORA?

The Board has been tracking COVID-19 information as it becomes available. Our primary concern is keeping our employees and Members safe. There have been many discussions on how to best do this!

‘To flatten the curve’ does not mean the virus is eliminated. They are trying to reduce the number of people who have it at the same time.

Colorado’s governor has requested people remain at home. Some Colorado Counties have requested non-residents keep driving through without stopping, and others are fining people driving about without a medical or grocery requirement. This situation changes from day to day. The Board cannot tell you what will happen in a week much less a month. Please be safe, stay home, and follow all government guidelines.

At this time there are no plans to shut CORA totally down. Everything depends upon the State of Colorado, Federal, and Park/Chaffee County guidelines.

Preparations for the season begin in late January and early February when our first order for toilet paper, towels, soap, and cleaning supplies is placed. The distributor canceled the order in March as they cannot meet all the demand. The order was placed again on Friday but we are uncertain of how much will be available. Colorado based Board members are obtaining supplies where they can.

If you do violate Colorado state guidelines and come to CORA you do so at your own risk. Please take precautions to protect others during your visit.

The Office is too small for safe distancing so we ask you to remain at the door. The clubhouse and kitchen are closed to all gatherings. Alex and Patricia have increased the cleaning schedule but we encourage you to wipe down surfaces before and after you use them.
